

## ORDINANCE NO 2

AS ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF WHITE RIVER MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT UNDER THE POWERS, AUTHORITY AND PROVISIONS OF TITLE 128, CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 8280-198 OF VERNON'S ANNOTATED TEXAS STATUTE, PRESCRIBING AND LEVYING DOUBLE ADMISSION FEES FOR PERSONS MAKING UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY, AND PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES AND POWERS OF PEACE OFFICERS OF SUCH DISTRICT WITH RESPECT TO UNAUTHORIZED ENTRIES IN SUCH AREA; PROVIDING FOR FAILURE TO PAY SUCH DOUBLE ADMISSION FEES AFTER UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY CONSTITUTES VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING SUCH OFFENSE TO BE SEPARATE OFFENSE FROM OTHER VIOLATIONS AND CUMULATIVE OF ANY OTHER OFFENSES COMMITTED IN VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCES OF SAID DISTRICT; PRESCRIBING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND RESPECTIVENESS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF WHITE RIVER MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT:

### Section I

It shall be the duty of the designated peace officers of said District to apprehend any person or persons who shall make unauthorized entry into the White River Municipal Water District Lake, either by entering the same in any manner at any place not designated for such entry, or by reason of failure to stop and make payment of the prescribed fees or charges for such admission, and upon apprehending any such person or persons who shall make such unauthorized entry, any such peace officer is hereby authorized and directed to demand and receive from such person or persons, for and in behalf of said District, as a permit fee which is hereby levied, a sum of money equal to two times or double the amount prescribed for the normal permit charges or fees; and failure upon the part of any such person or persons to comply with said demand and make immediate payment of said admission fees in said amount double the normal prescribed permit fee, shall be considered as a violation of this ordinance, and any person or persons so violating shall be subject to prosecution therefore as a separate offense. The offense of failure to pay such double admission fees after unauthorized entry shall be regarded as an offense separate from any other offense under the ordinances of this District, and may be considered as cumulative of any other offenses which may be committed in violation of such ordinances.

Section II

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefore, shall be fined in an amount which, combined with the cost of court, shall not exceed the sum of \$100.00.
