

ORDINANCE NO 3

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF WHITE RIVER MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT UNDER THE POWERS, AUTHORITY AND PROVISIONS OF TITLE 128, CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 8280-198 OR VERNON=S ANNOTATED TEXAS STATUTES OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS AS APPROVED AND ADOPTED WHICH SHALL HERE AFTER CONSTITUTE THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE WHITE RIVER MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSES SET OUT HEREIN AND IN REGARD TO THE MATTERS TREATED HEREIN.

Paragraph 6e of Section 1 of the General Rules and Regulations of the White River Municipal Water District enacted on the 1 day of September, 1966 by the Board of Directors of the White River Municipal Water District is hereby amended as follows;

6 e-- A RECREATION PERMIT shall be required of every person over 12 years of age who enters the areas of the White River Lake of the White River Municipal Water District, and said RECREATION PERMIT shall be official designated entrance fee for entry to the area around the White River Lake and the lake proper. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to evade or attempt to evade by any method or means the payment of this said fee for Admission to or use of White River Lake Area or any facilities contained herein.

Fees for said RECREATION PERMIT shall be as follows;

24 hour recreation permit-----\$2.00
Individual Annual Permit-----\$15.00
Family Annual Permit-----\$30.00

The family Annual Permit shall include a man and his wife and single children living at home. All Annual Permits are valid from January 1 to January 1.

Any person for whom a recreation permit is required under the prevision of this Ordinance shall have a valid recreation permit in his or her possession at all times while within the White River Lake Area and upon request shall exhibit the same to any peace officer or other designated official of the District. Failure to have such permit in posses or to exhibit the same as herein provided shall be construed as a violation of the provision of this ordinance.

Said Recreation Permit shall permit the person to admission to the White River Lake area and all recreation activities except camping privileges.

Paragraph 13 and 14 of the General Rules and Regulations of the White River Municipal Water District enacted on the 1 day of Sept. 1966 by the Board of Directors of the White River Municipal Water District is hereby amended as follows;

13.CBoat Permit-- A boat permit shall be required to operate a boat on White River Lake of the White River Municipal Water District. This permit shall be a 24 hour permit.

Fees for said Boat Permit shall be as follows;

24 hour boat permit -----\$2.00

Annual Boat Permit -----\$30.00

Annual Permits are valid from January 1 to January 1.

Any person for whom a boat permit is required under the provisions of this Ordinance shall have a valid Boat Permit in his or her possession at all times while within the White River Lake area and upon request shall exhibit the same to any peace officer or other designated official of the District. Failure to have in his possession or to exhibit the same as hereby shall be construed as a violation of the provision of this ordinance.

14.CCamping Permit- No person shall engage in camping in the Camping area of the White River Lake area unless they have a valid camping permit.

Fees for said Camping Permit shall be as follows;

24 hour camping permit-----\$2.00

Camping shall be permitted in designated camping areas only and the areas shall be so marked.

Any person or persons for whom a Camping Permit is required under the provisions of this Ordinance shall have a valid Camping Permit in his or her possession at all times while camping in the White River Lake Area, and upon request shall exhibit the same to any peace officer or other designated official of the District, Failure to have such permit in possession or to exhibit the same as herein provided shall be construed as a violation of the provisions of this ordinance.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after the second publication of the notice of this Ordinance as required by law.
