

ORDINANCE NO 4

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WHITE RIVER MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT UNDER THE POWERS, AUTHORITY, AND PROVISIONS OF TITLE ____ ARTICLE 8280-198 VERNON=S ANNOTATED TEXAS STATUTE, REQUIRING OBEDIENCE TO LAWFUL INSTRUCTIONS, NOTICES AND SIGNS, AND PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES AND POWERS OF STATE OF TEXAS PEACE OFFICERS, PROVIDING FOR THE FAILURE TO OBEY ALL INSTRUCTIONS, NOTICES AND SIGNS CONSTITUTES VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING SUCH OFFENSE TO BE SEPARATE OFFENSE FROM OTHER VIOLATIONS AND CUMULATIVE OF ANY OTHER OFFENSES COMMITTED IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, PRESCRIBING A PENALTY AND PROVISION FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WHITE RIVER MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT.

SECTION I

No person shall fail or refuse to obey any lawful instructions issued by any peace officer, nor shall any person fail or refuse to obey any instructions or warnings displayed upon any sign erected by the District, which shall include ~~A~~NO SKIING~~@~~, ~~A~~NO WAKE~~@~~, and ~~A~~RESTRICTED AREA~~@~~.

SECTION II

NO fishing shall be permitted or boats permitted in the area marked by buoys at the water intake to the filter plant located on the south end of White River Lake.

SECTION III

No skiing shall be permitted in the upper parts of the White River Lake located North of the North Section Lines of Section 109 & Section 110, H & G N Railroad Survey, Block 2, Crosby County, Texas and shall be marked by buoys so stating a No Skiing Area.

SECTION IV

All boats or vessels operated upon any of the waters of the White River Lake shall be operated in strict accordance with the provisions of the Water Safety Act of the State of Texas, designated as Articles 1722a, or Vernon=s Annoted Penal Code of the State of Texas and all Amendments thereto, and such act, is hereby adopted in all of their terms and provisions by the Board of Directors of said White River Municipal Water District.

The provisions of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after the second publication of the notice of this ordinance as required by law.

This ordinance of the district heretofore enacted on this 12 day of May, 1977 witness the signature hereof on this day by Marvin McLaughlin, President of the District, with the imprinting of the White River Municipal Water District.
