

**Do I need to make an appointment to transfer my lease?** - Yes, please call beforehand to make an appointment that way we can make sure someone is here for your assistance.

**Who all has to be present for lot lease transfers?** - Both parties have to sign the transfer but do not have to sign at the same time. If the seller cannot be here, then they have to get their signature notarized, but the buyer is required to sign at the District Office to get all paperwork done.

**How do I purchase annual permits or ATV stickers on the weekend?** - At this time annual permits, annual boat permits and ATV stickers may only be purchased Monday - Friday at the District office during normal business hours. Daily permits can also be purchased at the Marina, the ticket booths (when Manned), or the self-permitting station located at Campground #1 beside restrooms northwest of dam.

**When does the Board meeting take place?** - The White River Municipal Water District Directors meet on the third Monday of each month at 7 p.m. at the District office. We encourage anyone to attend who is interested to keep up to date with our District.

**When is my water meter read?** - The water meters are read on the first of the month, are then mailed out, water bills are due by the 15th of the month. It must be postmarked by the 15th. **We do not go by the check date.** If the bill is not paid by the end of the month we will disconnect the meter and charge a reconnect fee of \$275.

**What can I use to cook with at the lake?** - We are currently in a **Burn Ban**. At this time we recommend the use of covered cookers. For visitors it is typical for our area to have at least a 5-10 mph wind gusts.

**What are the normal business hours?** - Monday - Friday 8 am - 5 pm closed from 12 p.m to 1 p.m for lunch. Business address is 2880 FM 2794 Spur Texas, 79370. Phone number: (806) 263-4240

**How do I report a water break?** - During normal business hours call the office number listed below. Emergency or off hours contact the Field Supervisor at 806-269-1237.

**Are the boat ramps usable?** -At this time we have one Temporary boat ramp in the water, for any other questions please contact the office, at 806-263-4240. Signs are posted on the individual boat ramps and are updated.

**Is hunting allowed?** - Absolutely not! Our Police Chief and Texas Parks and Wildlife Game wardens patrol our lake area and enforce State laws and District rules.

**Do we have water and electricity at our camp grounds?** - We have full RV hook ups at Campground #2; there are 10 spots available at a first come basis. No reservations taken.

**Do we have sewer hook ups?** - Yes we have full hook-ups at our Campground #2 location. The fee for RV hook-ups is \$25.00, this includes camping fee, visitors are required to purchase Recreation permit at \$6.00 per person per day. Age 12 and younger free.

**Do we allow trout lines?** - No only throw lines with 5 hook max and no floatation device

**Do we have a covered structure for family gatherings?** - Picnic tables are covered at four campground sites.

**Do we have a fishing pier?** - Yes, at Campground #1

**Do we allow the public to ride ATV's?** - Not at this time. Lot lessees only.

**What type fish do we have?** - Catfish, Crappy, Bass, Sand Bass, Walleye and Blue Gill.

**Am I required to have a water pressure regulator put on my water line?** - Yes it is now a requirement that all lot owners have a water pressure regulator installed at lot lessee's expense.
