

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE White River Municipal Water District UNDER THE POWERS, AUTHORITY AND PROVISIONS OF TITLE 128, CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 8280-198 OF VERNON'S ANNOTATED TEXAS STATUTE, REGULATING THE TRAFFIC OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON THE PROPERTY OF THE White River Municipal Water District: REGULATING THE TYPE OF JET POWERED BOATS THAT MAY ENTER UPON THE PROPERTY OF THE White River Municipal Water District, AND DECLARING SUCH OFFENSE TO BE SEPARATE OFFENSES FROM OTHER VIOLATIONS AND CUMULATIVE OF ANY OTHER OFFENSES COMMITTED IN VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCES OF SAID DISTRICT: PRESCRIBING A PENALTY, AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLISHING AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE White River Municipal Water District:

SECTION 1

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a non-street legal motorcycle, 4-wheeler, or golf cart on the property of White River Municipal Water District that does not have a valid lot lease permit sticker attached to the vehicle. A permit sticker will not only be issued to lake lot leases. Any persons caught without a permit will be asked to leave District Property. Anyone caught driving excessively fast or reckless will be asked to park their vehicle and their permit could be revoked

SECTION 2

All Jet powered boats entering upon the property owned by the White River Municipal Water District shall have a manufacturer's factory installed thru-transom water injected exhaust systems. The motor shall be in a completely enclosed compartment and the motor shall not be turbo-charged to increase the power of the boat from the original power of the motor, or any other device to increase the power of the motor or boat.

Any Jet powered boat in violation of the above requirements shall be prohibited from entering the property of the White River Municipal Water District.

SECTION 3

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefore, shall be fined in the amount which, combined with the cost of court, shall not exceed the sum of \$200.00

The provisions of this ordinance shall be in force and effect five (5) days after the second publication of the notice of this ordinance as required by law.
